Initiatives

Rise Against Hunger

This past March, IREF members joined the Isenberg community in supporting Rise Against Hunger, an organization dedicated to ending global food insecurity. In partnership with the Accounting Department, Beta Alpha Psi, the Department of Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Belonging, and EY, we participated in an educational session and helped pack meals for communities in need around the world.



Boston Networking Trip



In February, the Isenberg Real Estate Fund traveled to Boston to meet with alumni and professionals across the real estate industry. The day included a property tour, firm visits, and in-depth discussions about investment strategies, market conditions, and career paths in real estate.

At GID, we explored a multifamily asset and learned more about institutional investment approaches. At Eastdil Secured, we gained valuable insights into capital markets and current challenges in the life sciences and office sectors. We also visited a development site in Fenway, which was the focus of our case study for the BU Real Estate Competition.

The day concluded with a visit to Greatland Realty Partners, where we learned about the firm's growth and approach to value creation.

Junior Analyst Mock Pitch




Our team of eleven Junior Analysts were divided into three groups, each assigned a different real estate deal representing unique investment strategies. Over the course of several weeks, each group conducted in-depth underwriting and analysis to evaluate the viability of their investments. The project concluded with formal presentations, allowing JAs to demonstrate their analytical skills, investment reasoning, and presentation abilities in a professional setting.

Boston University Case Competition

The Isenberg Real Estate Fund proudly made its debut at the Boston University Hospitality Real Estate Competition. The fund shared the opportunity along with 21 top real estate programs across the nation. Over six weeks, the team of six crafted a unique and complex ground up development proposal for a Fenway airrights parcel owned by WS Development.

Over the six weeks, the team was tasked with a full scale development proposal including design, analysis, and collaboration with Boston city rules and initiatives. The team had the opportunity to present to multiple development professionals and received strong feedback on their financial feasibility in a difficult case study. We are grateful for the opportunity to compete and look to build on this year's experience moving forward.
